

## Persons you can report to the ACT Integrity Commission

- Anyone who has public official functions for the Territory or is acting in a public official capacity for the Territory, including the following:
  - o A member of the ACT Legislative Assembly (an MLA)
  - o A member of staff of an MLA
  - A judicial officer
  - A presidential member, non-presidential member, assessor or registrar of the ACT Civil
     & Administrative Tribunal (ACAT)
  - o An officer of the Assembly
  - A statutory office holder
  - o A public servant, or
  - o Any other person who is an employee of a public sector entity or is a contractor, employee of a contractor, or volunteer exercising a function of a public sector entity.

ACT Government Directorates



Statutory bodies



Territory authorities and instrumentalities



Territory-owned corporations and their subsidiaries



Public health services, including hospitals



Public transport



Emergency services, excluding ACT Police



Public education



Gas, electricity and water supply, where exercising the functions is of a public nature



ACT correctional centres and places of detention
