### Clarification regarding ACAT decision concerning former ACT public servant

06 December 2024

The ACT Integrity Commission wishes to correct information within a recent decision published by the ACT Civil and Administrative Tribunal (ACAT).

In [Complainant DT232023 V The Australian Capital Territory \(Represented By Community Services Directorate\)](#), section 14 states:

***14. On 6 April 2023, the ACT Integrity Commission (Integrity Commission) executed a warrant to search the applicant's home in connection with a person that they were investigating and who the applicant had been seeing. There was no suggestion that the applicant had done anything wrong.***

ACT Policing did not execute this search warrant on the Commission's behalf. The search warrant was being conducted by ACT Policing for their own reasons.

During their search, ACT Policing located material that they believed would be of interest to the Commission, and subsequently made an information disclosure to the Commission.

After review of this information, the Commission lawfully provided the information to the relevant ACT public service Directorate who employed the individual, the Community Services Directorate, for their information and any action they deemed appropriate.

The Commission is currently working with ACAT to rectify the information within this decision.
