### Litigation outcome - ACT Integrity Commission Operation Juno

**11 December 2025**

The Commission notes the decision of Abraham J in the Federal Court of Australia, in favour of the Commission's findings, that Mr Walter Sofronoff engaged in serious corrupt conduct, as defined under the *Integrity Commission Act 2018*.

The Commission's investigation report, codenamed [Operation Juno](#), released on 18 March 2025, addressed the conduct of Mr Sofronoff. It examined the circumstances surrounding communications with, and disclosures of, confidential material made to journalists during his time as the Chair of the Board of Inquiry into the Criminal Justice System (the Inquiry), including the release of the report of the Inquiry before the report was made public by the Chief Minister.

On 19 March 2025, Mr Sofronoff applied for judicial review of the Commission's findings, with this application then amended on 14 April 2025. The first hearing was held on 21 July 2025.

The decision ([NSD 389/2025 Sofronoff v ACT Integrity Commission](#)) was handed down on 11 December 2025.
