ACT Integrity Commission Operation Luna update

25 June 2024

On 19 June 2024, the Integrity Commission advised that the Commissioner's Special Report into an aspect of its Operation Luna investigation has been completed. It further advised that an interested party commenced proceedings in the Supreme Court seeking an injunction to prevent the Commissioner from giving that report to the Speaker. That matter was heard in the ACT Supreme Court on 21 June 2024, with judgement being delivered today dismissing the application.

The Court has granted a temporary injunction that is in place until 4.30pm on 27 June 2024, to allow the Plaintiff the opportunity to file a Notice of Intention to Appeal, should they wish to do so. The order made by the Court on 19 June 2024, that the identity of that person not be published, remains in effect.

Operation Luna is the code name for the Commission's investigation into the conduct of certain Canberra Institute of Technology senior public officials relating to processes to procure consultancy services amounting to approximately \$8 million dollars.
