What does your role at the Commission entail?

My role consists of assessing reports of corruption and public interest disclosures which are reported to the Commission.

This involves reading a large number of documents, looking for open-source information and requesting additional information from reporters to determine whether corrupt conduct has occurred, or whether the report is a public interest disclosure.

What does your day-to-day look like?
